What's an Endowment Fund?

When people contribute to an endowment fund, that money will be left permanently unspent but invested so its income can be used regularly for various items. At Oak Hill, the money from the invested principal is used to purchase items not included in the day-to-day operating budget. These may be items that make the environment at Oak Hill more pleasant and beautiful, make care for the residents more convenient, or make living at Oak Hill more enjoyable.

What has the Endowment Fund provided to Oak Hill in the past?

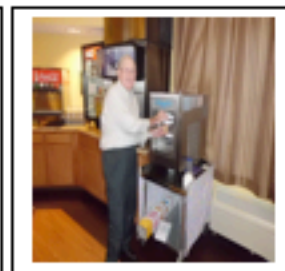

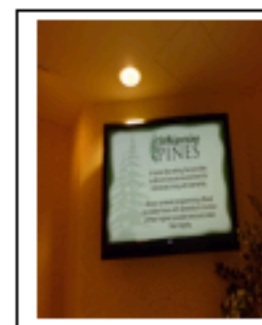

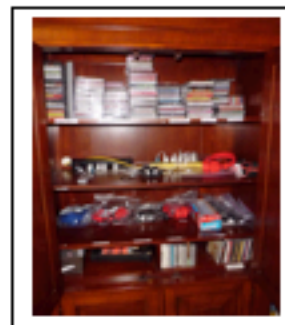
